

Transportation

- Most contracted Biennial Mission Summit hotels are on the MAX light rail train line, which will be the main source of transportation for attendees.
- ABCUSA is working in partnership with the Oregon Convention Center and Travel Portland, and attendees staying at contracted conference hotels will receive a maximum of two complimentary TriMet Transit Passes per room at check-in. This will give the attendee free access to trains, buses and streetcars in the city of Portland, including MAX light rail trains that stop at the Oregon Convention Center.
- TriMet passes provided by Travel Portland are valid only for the dates of the conference, June 30-July 2, 2017.
- There will be limited shuttle service available for the Crowne Plaza, which is not on the MAX light rail line.
