## **Congregational Vitality Index Categories**

Suggested by the Hartford Institute for Religion Derived from the U.S. Congregational Life Survey October 2004

- 1. Spiritual Growth (small group involvement, daily devotions)
- 2. Meaningful Worship (experiencing joy, awe, and meaning during worship)
- 3. Participation in the congregation (involvement in activities, giving)
- 4. Sense of belonging (participating more now than 2 years ago)
- 5. Care for young people (satisfied with youth offerings)
- 6. Focus on the community (involvement in bettering the community)
- 7. Sharing faith with others (at ease talking about one's faith, inviting friends)
- 8. Welcoming new worshipers (percentage of people who began attending < 5 yrs)
- 9. Empowering leadership (emphasis on using gifts, pastor inspires new ministries)
- Focused on the future (congregation has a clear vision focused on a balanced ministry - locally, nationally, and globally)
