## <u>11-14-13 4:30 pm</u>

- We will need a new convener
- Joyce Lake (works with Transition Ministries and AB Women in Ministry)
  She sings and has a group trying to raise money to go to Italy next year
- History overview Transition Ministries is new for ABCUSA to be handling, and it wasn't combined with Women in Ministry before.
- We don't have a lot of training, but that's being addressed.
- The idea of 'best practices' is not necessarily one that is common in Baptist circles, but it is something we have been looking at in this group.
- We had a grant approved for 2 year Spiritual Formation Initiative
  - 4 more conferences over a 2 year period
  - taking younger American Baptists on 2 pilgrimages Taize community, Spain/Georgia
  - o network of AB spiritual directors
- It's very difficult to 'unplug' ourselves and stay unconnected even for small periods of time. How do we hear the voice of God in this environment?
  - Some leaders don't think we are furthering the Kingdom if we aren't 'doing.'
  - Some people don't even realize the need for silence, alone time with God.
  - The world can go on without us.
  - Some people fear being left out.
  - These issues tie into pastoral burnout concerns, as well.
- Groups we connect with
  - Rhythms of Spirit initiative
  - Transition Ministries
  - Theologian's Conference
  - Ministers' Conference (Emerge)
  - Orientation to ABC Life
  - Professional Ministry Team representatives from various ABC organizations
  - Women in Ministry 57% of seminary students, only 9.8% of senior/solo pastors
    - Beyond this, there appear to be compensation differences between the genders, too.
    - Where does this gap come from?
- Women in Ministry was one of the 10 issues addressed at the Mission Table, so there seems to be passion & movement on this issue right now.
- What can we do to enhance our leadership?
  - Facilitate conversations between regional execs and seminary presidents?
  - Create 'honor roll' for ministries that support women in leadership?
- Can the next theologians' conference address gender issues in ministry?
- Maybe organize a conversation between REMC and AB colleges & seminaries.
- We want to propose that ABCUSA organize a conversation between the REMC and AB colleges & seminaries.

- Let's draw some connections
- How do we help folks stay engaged, and how do we come alongside workers in ministry who are just stuck?
- How would we raise the awareness of the board on the whole to the needs so that they become part of ABCUSA's agenda?
- ABCOPAD has pastoral small groups.
  - We heard this before (from the executive minister), but it didn't seem to register with the members of this group until we heard it from a pastor member of one of these small groups.
- Can we incorporate spiritual practices into the work of the BGM?
- Maybe the schedule for BGM meetings needs to reflect the balance we are going for. Perhaps it could include free time, fellowship time, outside experiences, etc.
  - Let's make an action item looking into this and doing a board retreat.
  - This may need to affect the work of the board because many people would not have the time to come for an extra day.
- Given the work and discussion of the Professional Leadership Response group, we recommend that the Board of General Ministries model best practices for our professional leaders.
  - Build best practices into the agenda such as dwelling on the word, fellowship, sharing one another's stories, praying with/for one another, outside experiences, etc.
  - Perhaps building a board retreat into the meetings, ideally without taking more time from our members' lives.
  - Appoint a discernmentarian for BGM meetings.
- The ministers' council has a discernmentarian. Should the board have something like this?
  - The vice president has been given the task of being the board chaplain, and the incoming vice president is certainly a gifted woman in ministry who has gifts & talents in this area? However, are we putting too much on the vice president? What about when we get a vice president who does not necessarily have these gifts?
  - Can we ask particular board members to fill this role for specific meetings?

## <u>ACTION ITEMS</u>

- We want to propose that ABCUSA organize a conversation between the REMC and ABC colleges & seminaries.
- Given the work and discussion of the Professional Leadership Response group, we recommend that the Board of General Ministries continue to model best practices for our professional leaders by:
  - Building best practices into the agenda such as dwelling on the word, fellowship, sharing one another's stories, praying with/for one another, sharing outside experiences, etc.
  - Perhaps building a board retreat into the meetings, ideally without taking more time from our members' lives.
  - Appointing a discernmentarian for BGM meetings.
- Recommend that the Theologians' Conference planning committee consider exploring theological thinking around women in ministry.
