

President's Report-March 2016:

I find my heart humbly grateful as I enter into my first ABCUSA President's report. In early February, our Interim General Secretary, Susan Gillies, and I had an email exchange. In it I articulated my goals as your president in this biennium.

First-To lead us through the search process for a new General Secretary with grace and a heart open to discern the leading of God's Spirit among us. I daily find myself in prayer for this process. With thanks to American Baptists connecting with other American Baptists, we will be voting in Zina Jacque and Tom Ross as General Directors on BGM. Zina will serve on the Executive Committee and Tom on the Nominating Committee. This completes the required number of persons in those positions. I worked with Tom Ross on the American Baptist Foundation Board and have experienced Zina's leadership. They both bring tremendous gifts and insight into their role on BGM.

In the past two months, Susan Gillies and I have been connecting via email and phone conversations. I'm so very grateful for Susan's leadership as our Interim General Secretary. I find in her a woman of faith who is grounded in reality and centered in Christ. Her wisdom has already blessed us greatly.

It is an exciting time for us. May we listen to God's leading and continue as people of faith committed to sharing the love of Christ and bringing justice, mercy, and hope to all people.
