AMERICAN BAPTIST HAITIAN CAUCUS Annual Report 2015 - 2016 Rev. Dr. Edgard Nicolas, President

The followings items are activities held from the previous year by the Haitian Caucus.

1. ANNUAL GATHERING (11/28/15)

An estimate of three hundred people gathered at Eglise Baptiste de la Nouvelle Jerusalem in Irvington to celebrate the 31st HAITIAN CAUCUS anniversary. Three members from the Baptist Convention came from Haiti to support the Haitian Caucus ministry here in the United States. The event started with a Bible study led by Rev. Dr. Lee B. Spitzer, ABCNJ Executive Minister. Several workshops were conducted by different instructors such as: Women, Rev. Mireille Daniel from Massachusetts; Men, Rev. Eugene Gedeon from Haiti Pastors, Rev. Dr. Ricardo Bonachy, Thelemaque; Massachusetts Youths, Rev. Dr. Kenslio Ojentis; New Church Development, Rev. Jimenez Oswaldo; Children, Sr Vena Ulysse, Massachusetts. Rev. James Stallings, former Executive Minister from Metro New York, was Keynote Speaker for the PM worship and was recognized and honored by a beautiful plaque presented by the Haitian Caucus board. He also received a very nice handmade art piece with his picture on one side and on the other a picture of the new hospital recently built in Haiti.
