Report of the Emerging Theologians Commission

The Emerging Theologians Commission is working to plan the Emerging Theologians Conference for Thursday, June 29th. We have sent out the call for papers with a conference theme of "The Church's Public Witness." We have set the conference fee at \$100 and are hoping for 70 registrants. We will cover the air fare and two nights at the hotel or commission members, and ask each commission member to lead a seminar group or participate in the closing panel. Our rough budget is as follows:

Six commission members x 2 nights in hotel x \$180/night = \$2,160Planning meeting meal of 6 commission members x \$25/person = \$150Rental of plenary room + 2 additional breakout rooms = \$1,600Plenary Speaker (\$360 for 2 nights in hotel + \$500 airfare + \$500 honorarium) = \$1,360Lunch \$20 x 80 people (70 registrants + 6 commission + 4 others) = \$1,600
