Literacy is our Major Program



This summer our camp used KidzLit. It develops core values of helpfulness, fairness, personal responsibility, and respect for others.

Leaders use a five-part process in which children hear engaging books read aloud or independently and make connections to their own lives. They express their feelings and grapple with big ideas through discussion, drama, art, movement, and writing. The program is aligned with the National Council of Teachers of English (NCTE) standards. All our students advanced at least one reading level this summer.

We are continuing this program after school throughout the academic year, Tuesday and Thursday afternoons. The program is free to students whose families are at the poverty level. It is funded by donations and grants.

Other Activities

Micah Center has been working with the Southern Poverty Law Center on education in Pinellas County Schools. Saint Petersburg has the five worst rated elementary schools in the state. A series of workshops and information conferences are being planned to inform the community and work toward school reform.

Working with three congregations and a number of lawyers Micah Center is developing a Gospel Justice Initiative Center. The mission is to provide a comprehensive program of educational outreach, legal assistance, and conflict resolution services to empower the powerless, give hope to the hopeless and show mercy and compassion to those in need. Faith motivates our desire to serve. Most of major programs – legal and conciliation – are free, except for very small and affordable administrative fees. This ensures that those who need our services will obtain them regardless of their ability to pay. We anticipate a soft opening in August 2016
