## Grant Matthew 25 Grant Proposal 2015 Oasis of Faith Campus Ministries at UMass Boston

Oasis of Faith CM exists to support the spiritual, moral, and intellectual development of the individual, an ethic of mutual social justice, and a commitment to service in and beyond the college community.

Oasis of Faith Campus Ministries is the Protestant Campus Ministry that has existed at University of Massachusetts, Boston since 1974. The ministry is recognized by The American Baptist Churches of Massachusetts.

My Campus Ministry colleague Sister Dorothy Castles and I recognized more than 10 years ago that some of our students were homeless, and many more were not able to afford tuition, books, lab fees, transportation, and food. Hospitality in the Interfaith Chapel, now known as the Interfaith Center, had long included hot water to make tea and instant coffee, cookies and candy. The urgent need of several students made us spend more of our hospitality funds on snack crackers instead. The snack crackers are not funded by the university.

For many the crackers are the bridge between the campus classroom and the off-campus job. For some it is the nutrition that leads to an exam, or the next class. As one student admitted in the Spring, "I just can't afford to buy food on campus and the food I packed from home is already gone." The university finally admitted the reality of homelessness and hungry a few years ago. U-Access was established as a part of Student Affairs.

I would like to supply 150 imprinted reusable grocery bags with our logo and words of inspiration, filled with staples, and a guide for economical nutrition. A grocery gift card will be available for students. I would also like to share a portion of the funds with U-Access in gift cards to grocery stores that are close to the university and accessible on the public transportation system.

I will aid the students I know who are financially stressed, seek names from the Veterans Upward Bound program and work with colleagues in the university community.

In addition, Oasis will offer a community meal in the Fall and in the Spring. If funding permits we will offer more meals.
