To purchase food to feed people in our community breakfast and dinner each month. To purchase secured deep freezer/ refrigerator and storage cabinet for the purchase of bulk frozen and shelf stable foods at low cost from Feeding America Eastern Wisconsin. To purchase a convection oven to efficiently and safely prepare quick meals for our Summer Enrichment Campers. To purchase secured storage racks / shelving for distribution of donated clothes to be given to the needy in our community each month.

4. How will the funds assist individuals battling poverty and its effects?

This year, our partners at Feeding America Eastern Wisconsin have asked agencies to support a piece of legislation that increase the amount of free, fresh, healthy and nutritious food for distribution to food pantries like ours if passed and signed into law. The proposal is called "Harvest for Hope."

In addition to possibly providing some individuals with their only meal of the day, we offer clothes via our clothes closet, fresh produce and bread to help stretch food budget and introduce people to a variety of produce they don't have access to. There are no large food stores in the neighborhood and the corner stores and gas station don't offer healthy choices.

Calvary Baptist Church is located in the 53206 zip code of Milwaukee, WI.

This area has the highest crime, incarceration and highest unemployment rate (60%), the lowest high school graduation rate (49%), the highest teen pregnancy and infant mortality rate and the highest incidence of poverty in Milwaukee County. We also provide the meals for our six week summer day camp for children 3-12 years of age. The camp serves the children a breakfast and lunch daily. Summer camp statistics indicate that nearly half of the participants were eligible for free or reduced meal rates according to federal guidelines and some were eligible for a scholarship to attend the camp.
