Grant funds may not be used to fund staff positions.

***Plan for requested funds***

The Braman Food Pantry has been in continuous operation at our Church since the 1980s. We have historically been serving 40-50 families per month from Schenectady, Montgomery and Schoharie Counties. Food items are supplied largely from donations and supplemented by purchases made at the National Food Bank.

The needs have increased greatly during this past year due to the slow economy, unemployment and lack of opportunities in the rural areas surrounding our ministry area. This has prompted us to take stock in what we can do to meet these increasing needs.

Therefore, we are looking to enlarge Braman Hall Food Pantry. By increasing and updating the area where we serve families in need, we would be able to have more food supplies on hand at all times. We could also offer extended hours for those with transportation issues to be able to get to us.

In addition, we have now partnered with the Red Cross to use our facilities for disaster relief when necessary. In light of this, it would be advantageous to have emergency and personal care supplies in addition to food items to help, which would also require additional storage space.
