## **ABCUSA MATTHEW 25 GRANT APPLICATION**

#### **Mission Statement:**

The Women's Ministry of the Church of the Redeemer Baptist, is a ministry devoted to community activities and affairs; to embrace and enrich the total life of humankind spiritually, economically, educationally, socially, morally and politically.

## Financial Statement of the Women's Ministry:

The Women's Ministry at the Church of the Redeemer Baptist, has a **\$600** yearly budget, which is allocated to its annual Women's/Mother's Day celebration. However, the ministry continues to sponsor programs and events for women, children and men, by partnering with local agencies and ministries of the Church of the Redeemer. This past May, for example, we hosted a Women and Girls Health Fair, targeting African-American and Hispanic women and girls. Approximately 100 guests attended, and there were more than 30+ health professionals as vendors. We used part of our budget to help advertise, and the other portion was used on Mother's Day to purchase gifts for the women in the community and congregation. The project was financially supported by the Office on Women's Health, and underwritten by various ministries of the church.

The Women's Ministry has a successful record of developing and implementing programs that have proven to positively impact its community. From Community Fairs to Christmas celebrations for shelters housing women and children, this ministry seeks to meet the needs of the "whole person". As a ministry, we have intentionally contributed to our community regardless of whether there was funding in our budget, or a "0" balance.

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#### **USE OF REQUESTED FUNDS:**

The Church of the Redeemer is located in the Point Breeze section of South Philadelphia. Over the past several years, Redeemer has continued to extend its hands to this community. Today, we are facing a crisis with the Philadelphia Public School, which has threatened to leave the doors of some schools closed. With this in mind, the Women's Ministry has made a decision to provide an Afterschool Program for children in grades 4-8 who will be affected.

If our children are to be successful, we believe the church must take an active role in providing services that will enhance their education. We propose to have an Afterschool Program that will include **Reading and Financial Literacy** for children. In addition to the children in our community, we will target the McDaniel Elementary School; one of which we have supported yearly (i.e., financial donations, purchasing of school uniforms, etc...). This project will be done in partnership with one-on-one assistance of our Senior Saints ministry and other retired volunteers.

Many of the children at the McDaniel School, are below reading level, and live below the poverty level. This Afterschool Program will provide motivation to build up reading skills, and offer tutoring support on other subject matters. We also want to introduce Financial Literacy, with the hope and expectation to instill into them that "poverty" does not have to be the final answer to their lives. If a child can learn to read, s/he can experience limitless possibilities! Likewise, if they can learn there is NEVER enough money for everything they may want, financial literacy at this age, can perhaps, help them to decide what is important to them.
