Question 2a: Mission Statement

In accordance with directives given by the Scriptures (Deuteronomy 15:11, Proverbs 28:27, Matthew 25:34-45, James 2:15-16, 1 Timothy 6:18 and 1 John 3:17-19) the mission of the Personal Needs Pantry is to provide families in our community who are struggling with job loss, financial instability or poverty a way to obtain basic necessities, allowing them to maintain personal dignity and a healthy home environment.

Question 2b: Financial Statement

The Personal Needs Pantry is a ministry of First Baptist Church of Jacksonville, Illinois that is supported completely by special offerings and product donations from our congregation and community. As such, we do not have a budget or audited financial statement for this project. Statements of income and expense are included with this application.

In 2013, the Personal Needs Pantry received financial contributions of \$5,458.26 and expended \$4,357.12 of that amount. Purchases were made in bulk from local retailers and a Chicago-based wholesaler to reduce cost and stretch funding as much as possible. In addition, an undetermined amount of product donations supplemented our purchases. We continue to make use of store loyalty and rewards programs to further our buying power.

Question 3: Proposed Use of Funding

First Baptist Church of Jacksonville, Illinois, is requesting funding from the ABCUSA Matthew 25 Grant to provide continued support to our outreach ministry, The Personal Needs Pantry, which provides items that are not serviced by the typical food pantry or covered by SNAP (food stamp) benefits. These items can be expensive but are necessary to maintain quality of life and a healthy home environment. These are things such as: toilet paper, shampoo, soap, razors, shaving cream, tooth/oral care products, facial tissues, bandages, laundry detergent, dish soap, diapers, feminine hygiene products and other personal care and/or household cleaning items.

In 2013, the Personal Needs Pantry hosted 263 visits to our outreach, serving a total of 602 persons. Of those 263 visits, 113 were unique (non-repeat). We accepted clients referred from the Salvation Army, local churches, social service agencies, other outreach programs, and government offices. We also help those who self-refer, but rely mostly on other agencies to identify needy families.

In recent weeks, we have partnered with an advertising/public relations class at one of the local 4-year private colleges in Jacksonville. As a class project, they will develop a plan to generate more knowledge of and interest in the Pantry. Once the project is complete, we anticipate implementing many of their suggestions, which we believe will increase awareness and utilization among the constituency we serve.

As awareness increases, the demand for products will increase accordingly. If granted this request, all funds received will be used to procure personal care and household cleaning items such as those listed above. As a church ministry, there are no salary or overhead considerations attached to this project; all funds will be spent on products to distribute to the needy.
