Konnection Kidz Children's Ministry Mission Statement

Konnection Kidz Children's Ministry opens their hearts and doors to children in the Valley Center community to build relationships, meet physical needs and evangelize boys and girls with the Gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ, and then teaching them to share His love with others.

How the funds would be used and how they will assist individuals in poverty.

Children are important to Jesus and to Grace Connections Church! Grace Connections recognizes the importance of introducing children to the love and forgiveness of God through a personal relationship with Jesus Christ. Because of this high priority to reach children in our community for Christ, one year ago, we hired a part-time youth minister and maintain an active ministry called Konnection Kidz. This ministry is an outreach to all un-churched children in the town of Valley Center, Kansas. The children's ministry has flourished for many years with the greatest draw on Wednesday Nights. We feel like one appeal to our Wednesday night Konnection Kidz Ministry is the free meal offered prior to our Bible Classes. While evangelism is our first priority, we recognize that children with full stomachs will be more receptive to the Gospel. This is why we are requesting your assistance.

Our church is located in the city limits with many low income neighborhoods within walking distance. We average 60 people every Wednesday night for a meal and Bible Classes. Seventy five percent of these individuals are children. A majority of the children we are working with walk to church without any parental presence. Several of our church members living in Valley Center see first-hand the poor living conditions and food shortage many of the children that come to our Wednesday night service are experiencing. It is common for a child to share with us that their "parent is in jail", or "the police were at our house last night". These children's families also tend to be extremely transient, furthering the insecurity these children feel.

With the high unemployment rates, rising costs of living and the desperate plight children and families we serve, our donations are low. Additionally, the salary of our part-time youth pastor, an increase in the numbers of youth attending our church because of his hard work, our budget is stretched as we strive to continue to serve free healthy meals every Wednesday night. Although we expect our numbers to continue to grow, because of the low economic status of the people we are called to serve, this growth will not greatly subsidize our budget. Despite all the obstacles previously mentioned we are determined to be a stable support system in the lives of these children. We know that the regular meals, Bible classes, and unconditional love of God we demonstrate on Wednesday nights provide a sense of security for these children.

Additionally, through our Konnection Kitz Ministry we are presented with many opportunities to minister to the parents of these children when we are alerted to needs such as food, clothing, or late utility bills. Frequently the children are the one's responsible for bringing their parents to church for special programs and dinners. Our objective is not only to minister to the children but to also reach their parents with the saving knowledge of Jesus Christ.

Our goal is to not only continue this Wednesday night Ministry, feeding the soul and the body, but to increase the number of children reached for our Lord Jesus Christ by 25% over the next year. We invite you to partner with us to continue to minister the "least of these" in Valley Center Kansas. This grant would be used to provide food for our Wednesday night meals, as we work towards our goals.
