Planned Use of ABCUSA Matthew 25 Grant Funds

As of August 31, 2013

During 2013, the Cleveland Foodbank, Inc. developed shortages with key food items supplied weekly to our Bread of Life Food Pantry, such as canned fruit & vegetables, milk, and meat items which are used to provide balanced nutritional meals to over eight thousand impoverished individuals and families throughout the Fairfax Community (Ward 6) of Cleveland each month.

Your ABCUSA Matthew 25 Grant Funds will be used to purchase these food items on a regular basis to offset Cleveland Foodbank, Inc. shortages of key food items delivered weekly to our Bread of Life Food Pantry to properly provide balanced nutritional meals to impoverished individuals and families served.

In addition, these funds will aid in purchasing food items used to prepare hot meals three times weekly by our Loaves & Fishes Program for impoverished individuals served at Antioch Baptist Church throughout the year.
