# **ABCUSA MATTHEW 25 GRANT APPLICATION**



A generous donor has given a sum of money through American Baptist Churches USA to be used for programs that address "housing, feeding, education and health with regard to the less fortunate." A panel will select recipients for grants of up to \$5,000 largely based on the degree to which the funds will be used to *directly assist persons in poverty*. Grant funds may not be used to fund staff positions or for capital improvements to facilities. Grant awards will be sent to the ABC church or Region, checks will not be made payable to an individual or ministry.

## Specifically, how do you plan to use the requested funds?

In the last two years, our congregation has been challenged to be more outward focused. One of our members, a local contractor, proposed a ministry called, "Ramp Up His Glory," to provide residential wheelchair/walking ramps for disabled people who could not otherwise afford them. He will donate his expertise in design and pursuing appropriate permits. A local building supply company will provide lumber and supplies at cost. A local printer has donated simple signage and T-shirts. Members of the congregation will donate labor. Grant funds are needed to purchase the lumber and other supplies for the ramps.

## How Will the Fund Assist Individuals Battling Poverty and Its Effects?

Through medical supply companies (those who provide wheelchairs) and other community medical providers, we will identify people who need the ramps but cannot afford them. We will ask the recipients to pay whatever they can, understanding that it won't be much. Materials for the ramps cost from \$1,000 - \$1,500, depending on specifications. Grant funds are needed specifically to purchase materials for the ramps. We already have one project in process. Weather permitting, it will be built March 12th.

## **Total Cost of the Project:**

Each ramp is 1,000 - 1,500. We are planning on at least three ramps this year. The more funding we receive, the more ramps we can build.
