In 2014 our Mission & Evangelism Board was able to do the following:

We donated baby clothes, diapers and supplies to our Pregnancy Center. Most was donated by the church but our board also included \$50.00 cash

We gave \$250.00 worth of Christmas presents to underprivileged children

\$200 was given to Brown Bag ministries from our Matthew 25 grant for sandwiches, fruit, water that they go out once a month and give out brown bag lunches. We are up to 175 each month. Brown bag also supplied, fire wood, blankets etc. for the homeless that live under our bridge.
