3. How do you plan to use the requested funds?

Given the ongoing state of our national economy, those of us who rely upon the generosity of others to provide humanitarian services to those most vulnerable in our society often feel like we are operating on a month-to-month basis. Though this feeling is often more about our fear of scarcity of resources, it only takes some set of unforeseen circumstances within one of our donor's lives, for funding sources to change, sometime dramatically, much like the stories we hear from those we serve regarding how they find themselves in their present condition.

Whatever funds we are fortunate to be the beneficiaries of would be used directly for food, paper products and kitchen supplies used for our Sunday night dinners.

Table Grace provides a meal, every Sunday, from 4:00-5:30 p.m., come rain, shine, snow, etc. For 2014, through August 24th, we have served on average, 336 plates per Sunday. That is a total of 11,472 plates of food served to our guest so far this year. Attached you will also see our Excel spreadsheet to see how much we spend, on average each Sunday on food and paper products.

Our guests reflect the most vulnerable in our community: the chronically homeless, working-poor families, street kids, single-parents, those struggling with addiction and/or mental health issues. We provide a safe environment for people to come and receive a home-cooked meal, small household items, toiletries, etc, as well as resourcing those who ask with community resources outside of our venue.

We have been involved in this ministry for over twenty years now. From its humble beginnings of serving sandwiches made by a handful of church ladies to this now community-driven partnership, Table Grace is committed to continuing serving the "least-of-these" within our community for years to come. Your grant can ensure that Table Grace stays committed to those in our community who are in need.
