Grant funds may not be used to fund staff positions, rainy day funds, church benevolent funds, regular ongoing church operating expenses (i.e. utilities, insurance), repairs, or for capital improvements or repairs to facilities. Grant awards will be sent to the ABC church that is applying for the grant; checks will not be made payable to an individual or ministry.

We work with school administratin to target the children who are most in need of extra food supplies on the weekends. The need to provide the ministry came to our attention through various personnel within the school system. It is our belief that children who are nourished when they come to school can concentrate on learning and take better advantage of their education.
- 5. Total cost of the project: Food cost varies per children served per year and is generally \$30,000-40,000 yearly.

- 6. Amount being requested from the ABCUSA Matthew 25 Grant: \$5,000.
- 7. List other funding source(s): We are largely funded by parishioner and community donations. We participate with Jackson County Community Foundation's annual Charity Challenge and receive matching funds of, generally, \$1000 per year.

The Snak Pak ministry of Parchment Valley Baptist Church is a backpack feeding program that feeds hungry children on the weekends throughout the school year. We have been conducting this ministry since 2012. We work with the administration and staff at the schools to provide packs of food on Fridays so that the children will have food supplements for the weekends. Guidance staff selects the children most in need and tells us the number of packs they will need on a weekly basis. All money donated/raised is used solely for food purchase. We are currently being utilized by eleven schools in Jackson County. Included is our end of the year report for the 2017-2018 school year. This is a large program that is largely funded by donations within our church and community. Each year we try to seek some help from alternative sources such as grant funding. We have received great feedback from the schools regarding this program and it's need in our impoverished community. Also included in the weekly packs are scriptures for the children to ponder.
