• In response to the problem of the growing number of girls re-entering the community after serving time in a juvenile or and adult correction facility. Galilee Ministries has been successful in assisting young girls promote healthy life styles by fighting poverty and promoting healthy relationships through our after-care program. We encourage positive youth development for girls through continuous youth engagement. We do not want to replace any of the systems that were learned by individuals while incarcerated, however, we offer an after-care ministry that will promote positive change for girls as they make their way back into the communities in which they live, giving them what's need to thrive not just survive. By empowering girls, fostering resiliency, offering family and community support the outcome has been very positive. Four young girls started a

job this Spring 2015, two started community college, and others are also moving forward in the program. We have not had anyone return to any detention or incarceration facility.

- Using trauma informed practices and positive youth development models we offer a safe space for girls to feel good themselves and their family as they become valued and productive family and community members.
- The long-term goals of Welcome Home/Stay at Home are to promote positive youth outcomes for high-risk and system-involved girls; and to reduce the rates of involvement and recidivism of girls in the juvenile justice system particularly for girls living in the City of Lynn and the surround North Shore communities.
  - Galilee Ministries has been able to strengthen the partnerships between community and faith-based agencies to form mentoring opportunities and community learning opportunities with caring adults by providing additional support for the girls.
- Peer networking, family support, employment training, and college conferences proved to be a very important component of the Welcome Home/Stay At Home After Care Program.

Participants can expect: Peer Support, Family Support, Fun, interesting, and thought-provoking activities, The opportunity to meet others who share similar experiences, build connections, develop networks, experience individual spiritual growth, intergenerational contact, and participation in community service projects.

## **PROGRAM DETAILS**

WELCOME HOME/STAY AT HOME (WHSAH) After-Care Ministry is a half-year long program. We will continue serving up to ten (10) girls two (2) times a week for the duration of the program. WHSAH will collaborate with Department of Youth Services (DYS), Department of Children's and Family Services (DCF) and other community and faith-based agencies. PROGRAM BUDGET
