2. MISSION STATEMENT

- Grace Baptist Church will provide food security and school supplies for youth in needy families. Our location across the street from San Jose State University (SJSU) puts us in a unique position to connect with needy students and provide them with nutritious food and school supplies.
- We will raise awareness of food deficiencies in SJSU and the role Grace Baptist Church has in the • ecumenical community that is working to provide for youth's food security and school supplies.

Grace Baptist Church is partnering with the Episcopalian Chaplaincy services at SJSU, the International Students fellowship, Intervarsity Fellowship, the Chinese Fellowship, The SJSU Food Pantry, and the SJSU Associated Students.

FINANCIAL STATEMENT

With the reduced supplies cost and food donations we are able to provide each student with a bag that consists of meal and school supplies for a cost of \$5.00 per bag

Although the need is even greater, our goal is to be in campus once a week and give out 40 bags to students who are in need.

This will provide 15 weeks each semester of food and supplies bags for 1,200 students, which is the estimated number of needy students in the 30,000 students campus of SJSU. The total cost for providing the food will be \$6,000.

3. PLAN TO USE THE REQUESTED FUNDS

Providing one meal and supplies bag a week to students at the poverty level in SJSU will allow them in to continue their good nutrition while school is in session. Our system of visible Grace Baptist Church volunteers, and selection at the Students Fellowships guarantees that when the needy student appears, a bag filled with enough food and school supplies is waiting for them right on campus. The bags contain only healthy items such as nutritious bars and pre-packaged meals, and school supplies such as pens, pencils, notebooks, markers, sharpeners, post-its, and toiletries.

It is unacceptable to Grace Baptist Church to take no action when under the eyes of Christ our youth go hungry or lack the most basic tools for their schooling. This project is a pilot project for other congregations to follow and it is building momentum of support to ensure food security and supplies for needy college students.

At the same time we will challenge the community to live for a week on \$4.28 per day as a means to raise awareness and empathy about this issue in our community.

At this point, our church is also exploring other steps to supply needs and create community concern and action.
