# Pinebelt Christian Women's Job Corps

How we plan to use funds received during 2014 -

For Christian Women's Job Corps, we need 7 – 10 computers. The ones we had were destroyed by last year's tornado. We always need paper and other office supplies for assignments. We need bibles (study bibles rather than KJV, which is hard for the women to read and understand). Our building at 411 N. 38<sup>th</sup> Avenue has been donated by 38<sup>th</sup> Avenue Baptist Church. However, we pay all insurance, utilities and upkeep for the house. All teachers and mentors donate their time and skills.

Good Hope Baptist Church (Lamar County) needs our help in getting their women's program started. This church is in a very poor neighborhood. All our instructors will need to travel the 15-20 miles to this location. All volunteers donate their time and absorb all expenses they incur.

The Men's Bible Study / Prayer group which meet every Friday morning in Hattiesburg have been helping us with the CWJC are most anxious for us to get the Men's group started. Many of them qualify as teachers.

Mississippi is the poorest, most uneducated state in the Union. We do not hand out funds for any purpose. We <u>do</u> give them the training to get and hold a job. During our last week of each session, we caravan the women to various businesses to apply for jobs. In our final class of 2013, half our women got jobs during the last week! Several at General Dynamics and others at Kohler. We've had several homeless women take our class; we see that they have a place to stay, until they get on their feet. We work closely with Salvation Army and other charitable organizations.

CWJC teaches Money Management – Conflict Resolution – Career & Job Skills –Health – Communications – and each day starts with Bible Study and Devotional. We have 2 to 3 classes every year, and class member has a mentor who works with her for one year. Pinebelt Christian Women's Job Corps is making a difference in South Mississippi.

In 1999 a group of faithful church leaders worked together through prayer to establish a Christian Women's Job Corps (CWJC) site in Hattiesburg. CWJC is a national ministry with over 185 sites across the country, 15 in Mississippi and has established sites globally. As a nationally registered CWJC site Pinebelt CWJC is required to complete national training, site registration, follow the mission statement and, adhere to the ministry's eight key elements.

Pinebelt CWJC's mission – To provide a loving environment for hurting women, where self-esteem is restored and real hope is offered. We strive to empower women as we help them discover and develop a realistic plan to set and accomplish personal, educational, and career goals. Pinebelt CWJC is a program that strives to change the lives of women spiritually, emotionally, physically, economically and socially - a HAND Up not a HAND Out.

- Journey 1 includes 10 weeks of intensive life and career skills classes; Bible study, computer education, money management, conflict resolution, communications, family dynamics, and career skills.
- Journey 2 requires that the participants work with their Christian Friend for a minimum of 7 months. This relationship is built upon trust, and encouragement, working together to set and achieve realistic goals.
- Pinebelt CWJC ministry an incorporated 501c (3) non-profit is funded by private donations.
- We operate with a Board of Directors, 2 staff, an annual operating budget of \$70,000 and an army of volunteers from local churches, businesses, and social service organizations.

Sunday February 10, 2013 changed the lives of hundreds in Hattiesburg and Petal as a tornado struck our communities. One of the areas heavily affected by the storm is where our Pinebelt CWJC Hattiesburg location was housed, 106 North 24<sup>th</sup> Avenue, our facility suffered irreparable damage. The facility was owned and graciously rented to us by one of our strong church partners Westminster Presbyterian Church. Since the storm we receive countless, emails, texts, phone calls, personal contacts all asking *What can I/we do?* 

- First and foremost our request is for prayer. We are more than a facility and God's Grace and Mercy are imperative. Please ask your church, your friends, your Bible study group and neighbors to include us in their prayer time.
- Financial support, as we evaluate the content and location loses; determine our immediate and future needs it is painful to think of rebuilding without strong financial backing. Replacing the Hattiesburg location is undoubted our greatest investment.
- We lost our facility, its contents, and the home that many of our current and former participants look to as a place of support, prayer, God's love and guidance.

# AMENDED AND RESTATED CHARTER of PINEBELT CHRISTIAN WOMEN'S JOB CORPS, INC.

### ARTICLE I - NAME

Section 1. The name of this corporation is Pinebelt Christian Women's Job Corps, Inc.

# **ARTICLE II - NON-PROFIT CORPORATION**

Section 1. The corporation is a non-profit corporation within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 and the Mississippi Nonprofit Corporation Act.

## **ARTICLE III - PURPOSE**

Section 1. The sole and exclusive purpose of this corporation is religious, charitable, and educational. Specifically, it is the purpose of this corporation to teach, mentor, and empower underprivileged and disadvantaged women who suffer from poverty, neglect, abuse, addictions, and other physical, mental, and social conditions that rob them of hope and impair their ability to find and hold jobs. This corporation seeks to use Christian principles to provide a loving environment for hurting women, so that self-esteem can be restored and realistic training and hope for employment are provided. Our volunteers and staff seek to provide the attitude, self-discipline, and educational tools to develop plans and accomplish personal, educational, and career goals. This corporation does not require its clients to subscribe to a particular set of beliefs before, during, of after the training, nor does it seek to indoctrinate women into a particular doctrinal or denominational set of beliefs. The motivation for our mission is the love of neighbor which is at the heart of Christianity. The strategic goal is education and empowerment so the underprivileged and disadvantaged women and families receiving help will be able to become economically self-sufficient. This organization is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding sections of any future federal tax code.
