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The Delano STEAM Tech Lab

The Delano Neighborhood in which West Side is situated is a low-income neighborhood full of elderly long-time res idents and struggling young families, and has a very low percentage of Internet-enabled households. The new Centra l Library was scheduled to be built in Delano with a completion date of 2012, but the economic downturn has pushe d that date back to 2015 or later. The "neighborhood" city hall (over a mile away) has a few workstations, but it too i s at risk with CDBG funding cuts.

West Side has a goal of turning the south wing of the church building into a community center, and the Raspberry Pi project offers an inexpensive way to include a computer classroom in this project. According to the charity that crea ted it:

"The Raspberry Pi is a credit-card sized computer that plugs into your TV and a keyboard. It's a capable little PC which can be used for many of the things that your desktop PC does, like spreadsheets, word-processing and games. It also plays high-definition video. We want to see it being used by kids all over the world to learn programming." The Pi also has onboard Ethernet, meaning it can be inexpensively connected to a wired Internet connection – in addit ion to teaching programming to kids, the Pi can be used to get grownups online in a world where it's increasingly essential to use the Internet just to get by.

Software is entirely free, open-source packages, including a Pi-specific flavor of Linux, the MIT-developed Scratch programming language, and the MS Office-compatible LibreOffice suite. Teachers will be volunteers, ideally follow ing the "Trade School" barter model, or provided in partnership with existing organizations like the Wichita Public Library, city Parks Department, and Wichita Public Schools.

The pilot project will be an eight-station network, with seven Pi's as student stations and a conventional PC as a teac her's station – capable of easily flashing SD cards for the Pi's, and functioning as a print server, etc. One workstation will be held in reserve as spare parts, and be available for students to purchase (at cost). Eventually, another switch and either eight more Pi's or full-blown laptops will be added when demand calls for it.

We anticipate four types of classes:

- Youth programming, with a focus on elementary and middle school students,
- Basic computer/Internet literacy, helping Delanonians fill out online applications and similar life skills,
- Basic job skills, teaching word processing, spreadsheet, and general office skills, and
- Business Internet skills, targeting neighborhood entrepreneurs and mom-and-pop shops of Delano's comme rcial district.

After the pilot equipment is purchased, the community will take over ongoing expenses of the center. The cost of the Internet connection will need continued sponsorship. An earn-a-Pi program (analogous to earn-a-bike programs) wil need a regular supply of donated Pi's, as will expansions to the classroom and replacement of damaged or worn-out keyboards, etc. Teachers not already certified by their own organizations will need background checks. Delano is a mixed-use neighborhood, filled with small and medium-sized businesses who generally feel a close connection to the residential neighborhood, so recruiting sponsors should be relatively easy.
