A generous donor has given a sum of money through American Baptist Churches USA Office of the General Secretary, to be used for programs that address "housing, feeding, education and health with regard to the less fortunate." A panel will select recipients for grants of up to \$5,000. Awards will be granted only to ministries of an American Baptist church in good standing with their Region. This is a change from previous grant cycles. We will no longer award grants to organizations affiliated with churches such as a cooperative group that includes non-ABC churches; applications must be submitted by an ABC church for work being done directly by that church.



Only one application per church will be considered within a 24-month period. Because this change was made following the Fall 2016 cycle, recipients of a Spring 2016 grant are eligible to apply.

Grant funds may not be used to fund staff positions, rainy day funds, church benevolent funds, regular ongoing church operating expenses (i.e. utilities, insurance), repairs, or for capital improvements to facilities. Grant awards will be sent to the ABC church that is applying for the grant; checks will not be made payable to an individual or ministry.

The money will be used to award 12 families (one per month) of drug addicted parents with a \$250 gift card that can be used to help their children with school supplies, clothing and anything else that can allow them to have a sense of normalcy. Many of these children are living with grandparents who are on fixed incomes themselves and do not have the means to provide all that the children need.

"I Wanna Testify" Recovery/Re-Entry Ministry (RRM) is a faith-based ministry, working with the communities of Lynn to address the problems of drug addiction and re-entry with men and women, and to strengthen and vitalize the life of our congregation. Our belief stems from Zion Baptist Church's motto: 'The church where love is put into action!

Through advocacy RRM of Zion acts to speak on behalf of those who are suffering from drug and other addictions, injustice and social ills.

The "I Wanna Testify" Recovery/Re-Entry Ministry is an outreach program established in September 2016. In the short time since we began, we have not only established group meeting participation, but held an announcement ceremonial event that included a testimonial to an honoree who first envisioned our program. We have also marketed ourselves within the church and the community of Lynn. We have partnered with the Behavioral Health Unit, located inside the Lynn Police Station, for additional substance abuse and mental health support.

- 4. How will the funds assist individuals battling poverty and its effects? What impact do you hope to make on the target group or community? Many of these children are living with grandparents who are on fixed incomes themselves and do not have the means to provide all that the children need. Many parents not only struggle from addiction but suffer mental illness as well. The children are caught in the crossfire. While our main focus is on the person with the addiction, these children are believing that the lives they have are exempt from hope and we need to help keep these children from choosing the same path of hopelessness.
