OUR MISSION

Our Mission is to create a Spiritual Community to worship, learn and have fun experiencing the power and presence of God. We explore spiritual truths to enrich our lives and the lives of others.

New Creation Church is located in one of the most impoverished communities in Montgomery County, Maryland. In an effort to address the challenges of poverty, the church has established ministries, such as the Food Distribution Program that provides free produce, non-perishable food distributed through Mid County United Ministries, the Summer Enrichment and Empowerment and Senior Adult Programs. Each month, regardless of weather, hundreds of people in the community form lines around the church to receive free food from the church.

The Capital Area Food Bank provides fresh produce monthly for the Produce Distribution, and Montgomery County Public Schools provides food for the Summer Program for Children.
