## **Use of Matthew 25 Grant Funds: Whitney Elementary**

One of the ways that Whitney Elementary has dealt with such a high poverty rate among their students and families is by setting up a Food Pantry and Clothes Distribution programs within the school. They give out "Food Bags" weekly to students and their families to get them through hard times. These bags contain all kinds of different food essentials for the students to use. However, the money for these food bags runs out very quickly as they continually stock the food pantry. As outlined in our budget, we want to be able to fund a number of these food items that go into these food bags. We have decided to include these various items for up to 100 food bags a month for the school: Cans of Ravioli, Ramen Soup, Fruit Cups, Juice Boxes, and Cereal Boxes. With this financial backing in supplying these items that go into these food bags, we can offer this school some stability as we seek to partner with them for the long term.

As well as provide various items to fill the food bags, we understand that during the winter months many of these children go without jackets, beanies, and gloves. We are aiming to be able to supply half the school's population with these clothing items. That would be 350 students receiving jackets, beanies, and gloves.

Using these funds in this way is just the beginning of our serving this school. We want to do more than provide these items. We have plans to send church members to the school to come alongside these children and serve them by tutoring, reading to, and even playing at recess with them. As we provide some much needed food and clothing items, we hope that this will open the door of mutual trust and love to allow us to develop deep relationships with everyone at Whitney Elementary.
