To Whom This May Concern,

Zion Baptist Church is located in Mahanoy City, PA. We are a small church located in a community that neighbors two prisons: one federal and one state. With that said, Mahanoy City houses many transient families with varied needs.

Tough economic times have fallen upon everyone; however, Mahanoy City has a poverty level of 67%. Serving as Christ in a poverty stricken area, ZBC is home to numerous ministries put in place to address many of the common concerns that are prevalent in low income neighborhoods.

Currently, ZBC hosts God's Chuckwagon. This is a mobile soup kitchen that comes to Mahanoy City weekly and provides a hot meal to whomever is in need. This ministry also allows the people to take an additional hot meal with them when they leave.

Bountiful Blessings is an outreach program that uses ZBC as a host site. This ministry provides essentials not covered by food stamps. Paper towels, bathroom tissue, hygiene needs are just a few of the core items offered bi-weekly.

Celebrate Recovery is a faith based 12-Step Program addressing those who have hurts, habits and hang-ups. Providing support and fellowship, many are able to find the strength and encouragement to move forward in their personal recovery.

Financial Peace University is offered twice a year at ZBC. Providing the education to help people pay debt and save money so they can "live like no one else." Dave Ramsey's tough love approach has touched many in our congregation.

The outreach committee has started a small non-perishable food pantry. By affording a \$20/bag of food, a family is able to receive a hand-up to make it through an emergency situation. However; this is a one-time only program as we are unable to fund a full food pantry at the moment.

After Easter, we are launching Embrace Grace: ministry for young single women. ZBC is also sponsoring "Head to Soul" which is a self-esteem, self-image ministry for girls 10-15 years of age.

Our church is known in the community for the numerous outreach programs. The school district; as well as, other churches send families our direction for assistance. ZBC is poised to continue these ministries; but, there are many more needs to be met.
