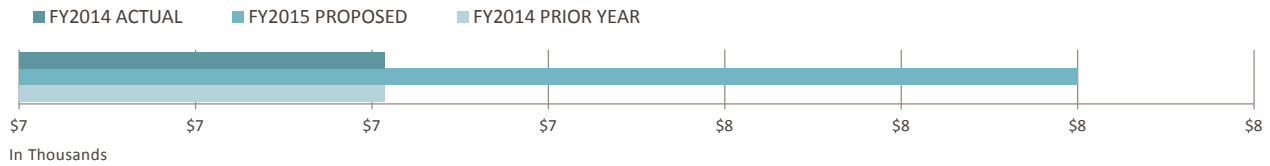
2. WE HAVE INCLUDED OUR MISSION STATEMENT ON OUR LETTERHEAD BUT TO ADD TO THAT, Mission Outreach Project is incorporated for the purpose of providing assistance to those who are homeless or at risk of homelessness. MOP provides hot lunches, along with clothing, blankets, hygiene packets and other items to benefit the welfare of clients we serve in Desert Hot Springs CA. MOP also provides individuals with linkages to other community agencies who may be able to further assist them on their path to self-sufficiency.

3. Funds will be used to purchase food. MOP volunteers cook and serve hot meals every Wednesday and Friday from 11-1. We serve about 600+ hot meals per month and approximately 350 meals at Thanksgiving. There is no charge for these services. Although some of our food is donated, much of the food and paper products to serve the food are provided by our ministry. If we receive donations of bread or vegetables we pass those on to our guests. Most importantly, we provide prayer and fellowship. Our hugs are free and plentiful!

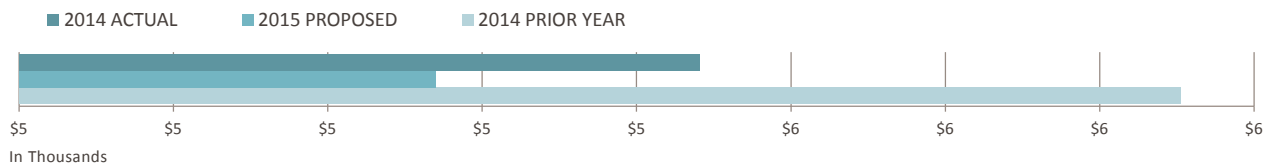
