Editorial Assistant

Role and Responsibility: The Editorial Assistant will primarily assist in coordinating IM website content and print publication content (text and graphics). The Editorial Assistant will be responsible for coordinating writers and designers, editing and proofreading, photo and editorial research, maintaining high quality standards and meeting production deadlines. In addition, the Editorial Assistant will upload and manage content on the website. He or she will monitor the IM webpage and when it is not functioning properly he or she will work with appropriate IM staff to rectify the problems. Some writing or re-writing for print and online content, assisting with social media and e-marketing content are required.
