- ✓ Work with ABHMS to determine the viability of a National Youth Gathering or other such strategy to reach and engage persons in High School and their first year of college.
- ✓ Develop and implement entry and follow-up strategies for Young Adult/Emerging Leaders in all ABHMS sponsored events.
- ✓ Develop a network of identified key 18 – 35 year-old leaders currently involved in ABHMS work.
- ✓ Develop engagement events including but not limited to pre or post-ABC Mission Summit Biennial, OTABCL, volunteer opportunities, key regional events, ecumenical partner organizations, and college outreach events
- ✓ Develop key relationships with ABC-related colleges and universities, regions, and other partners to identify potential leaders and key ministry objectives.
- ✓ Serve as a resource to key ABHMS partners in the area of 18 – 35 year-olds engagement.
- ✓ Consult with ABHMS scholarship and grant recipients regarding ministry to and with 18 – 35 year-olds.
- ✓ Consult and serve on teams with other ABHMS professionals to ensure inclusion of 18 – 35 year-olds in planning and implementation of ABHMS ministries and services.
- ✓ Utilize social media and other appropriate technology to connect and network identified 18 – 35 years-old leaders.
- ✓ Develop key engagement strategies/best practices related to ministries to and with 18-35 year-olds to disseminate to ABHMS partners.
- ✓ Attend key regional and special events as needed to meet and develop relationships with leaders.
- ✓ Ensure strategies and efforts associated with 18-35 year-olds ministry efforts align with ABHMS missional priorities and initiatives.
