Introduction To New Form Format – **RECEIVING UNITS**

Welcome to the newly redesigned Church Mission Support form! We hope this new format will make it easier for our ABC churches to submit their mission giving.

The upper left section still contains the normal contact information. The bottom section still contains the receipt from their last gift. The main section is the area that has been simplified.

To submit gifts for categories A – E (found in the upper right section), the church needs to enter the amounts. All other gifts (categories F - I) need amounts AND further description. This description should help you, as a Receiving Unit, understand where the church wants its monies to go.

Unfortunately, in order to provide more room to the churches, the coding section found on the old form had to be removed. But we've accounted for this by creating an optional WORKSHEET for you to use. Page 2 contains an example.

AMERICAN BAPTIST MISSION SUPPORT (ABMS) DEFINED

UNITED MISSION - United Mission contributions provide the largest portion of support and are the very foundation for all Am Baptist Mission. They are distributed on a percentage basis according to the covenant agreement between Region organizat international Ministries, American Baptist Home Mission Societies (ABHMS), Ministers & Missionaries Benefit Board (MMBB) merican Baptist Churches USA (ABCUSA, OGS), and career development centers. Regions receive on the average 65% of United

A. UNITED MISSION BASICS (UMB) - Gifts here support all parts of our national and international mission effort as American Baptists. These gifts are vital and basic to the work of all of our American Baptist family. UMB provides funding for most ministriative such as new church planting, evangelism, cooperative Christianity, Christian education for youth, and national and international and international control of the company of the comp

FT (LG) - American Baptist Women make over-and-above contributions to Love Gift. 15% of these contributions are port the work of American Baptist Women's Ministries, and the balance is divided in the same way as are gifts to United

- C. AMERICA FOR CHRIST OFFERING (AFC) Gifts are divided two thirds for the work of Mission in America through ABHMS,
- D. RETIRED MINISTERS & MISSIONARIES OFFERING (RMMO) This offering goes entirely to the Missionaries & Ministers Benefit Board to provide emergency relief and "thank you" checks to retired ministers and missionaries.
- E. REGION GIVING Gifts in this category are given 100% to the designated Region to use at their discretion for the budget, or for a particular purpose promoted by the Region.
- G. ONE GREAT HOUR OF SHARING (OGHS) Gifts provide disaster relief and development assistance in the United States and overseas, administered by the American Baptist World Relief Committee.
- H. ABCUSA, OFFICE OF THE GENERAL SECRETARY AMERICAN BAPTIST HOME MISSION SOCIETIES (ABHMS) INTERNATIONAL MINISTRIES
- Gifts are used toward the support of both general and specific projects for all of the National Boards. This includes
 missionaries. These gifts provide monies beyond the funded dollars for these projects. Such gifts are
 generally referred to as Specifics (SPC).
- Gifts are used to fund Missionaries' Salaries and the National Boards. These gifts are often the result of an appeal for iort. Such gifts are generally referred to as Targeted Giving (TG).
- Gifts are used toward the support of both general and specific projects for Regional and Institutional items. These gifts ride monies beyond the funded dollars for these projects. Such gifts are generally referred to as Specifica (SPC).
- *These gifts are for campaigns conducted by recognized American Baptist institutions, by American Baptist Region organizations, and by national Baptist organizations. Gifts to campaigns are over-and-above ABMS. Such gifts are generally referred to as CAMPAIGNS FOR ABC WORK (CPG).
- This category provides a channel for sending gifts to American Baptist Missionaries for their personal use, as well as to the
 erican Bible Society. Other non-ABC-related gifts should be sent directly to the organization. Gifts in this category are treated assthrough' gifts and are not tax deductible. Such gifts are generally referred to as MISCELLANCOUS GRIECTIVES (MO).
- Gifts provide support to American Baptist-related institutions in the United States for their operating expenses. These
 institutions include seminaries, colleges, campus ministries, student aid for colleges and seminaries, retirement homes, hospitals,
 children's homes, and our national conference/training center (ABA) at Green Lake, WI. Such gifts are generally referred to as
 INSTITUTIONAL SUPPORT (ISP).

This new WORKSHEET is nothing more than a new tool, replacing the coding parts of the form that were removed. Since it is completely optional, you may use it as you see fit. Obviously you won't need it when the gifts are clear and straightforward. But when they are fairly complicated, as in the example below, you may want to grab the worksheet and a ruler to get the job done. Once you have finished 'marking up' the worksheet, you may enter the data into the ABCIS database.
