A generous donor has given a sum of money through American Baptist Churches USA Office of the General Secretary, to be used for programs that address "housing, feeding, education and health with regard to the less fortunate." A panel will select recipients for grants of up to \$5,000. Awards will be granted only to an internal ministry of an American Baptist church which provides direct benefit to children. The church must be in good standing with their Region. This is a change from previous grant cycles. We will no longer award grants to organizations affiliated with churches such as a cooperative group that includes non-ABC churches; applications must be submitted by an ABC church for work being done directly by that church.



Only one application per church will be considered within a 24-month period.

Grant funds may not be used to fund staff positions or stipends, rainy day funds, church benevolent funds, regular ongoing church operating expenses (i.e. utilities, insurance), repairs, or for capital improvements or repairs to facilities. Grant awards will be sent to the ABC church that is applying for the grant; checks will not be made payable to an individual or ministry.

The monies will pay for the daily essentials needed for the girls to live in the small but safe apartment building. (More detailed page attached.)
- 4. How will the funds assist individuals battling poverty and its effects? What impact do you hope to make on the target group or community?
 - The funds will bring protection to the most vulnerable children who are living in the midst of dire poverty. The girls in the safe-house are there because most are orphaned due to HIV and diseases associated with extreme poverty. Some of them face violence brought about by living in a slum where 50% of girls between 12-19 have been physically or sexually abused, Without the safe-house project the children would be abused and face disease, no schooling, and likely early death. The safe-hosues literally save lives.

- 5. Total cost of the project: \$5,808 per year operating costs
- 6. Amount being requested from the ABCUSA Matthew 25 Grant: \$5,000
- 7. List other funding source(s): other churches help fund the safe houses including The Well, Modesto (another GHC church) and individual donors through When I Grow Up our missions partners. These funds are for one of three safe-houses being run by Furaha.

Awards will be granted <u>only to internal ministries</u> of an American Baptist Church in good standing with their Region <u>which provides direct services to or for children</u>. This is a change from previous grant cycles. We will no longer award grants to organizations affiliated with churches such as a cooperative group that include non-ABC churches or ministries where a church partners with other organizations; applications must be submitted by an ABC church in good standing.

When determining Grants awards, the following criteria will be considered: whether the church is in good standing within the region; whether the church contributes to United Mission; number of and amounts of previous Matthew 25 Grants received; sustainability of ministry beyond Matthew 25 Grant funding; description of ministry and needs addressed by funding; and the detailed budget submitted along with this application.

Checks will be made payable to the ABC church. Checks will not be made to an individual or ministry.

Additional description of proposed funding project with Matthew 25 2019 grant monies.

For 50% of the girls living in the Huruma slum, Nairobi Kenya will be subjected to physical or sexual abuse before the age of 19 years old.

Additionally currently 40% of the girls within the Furaha Community Primary School in Huruma are either HIV+ or are orphaned as a result of their parents being HIV+.

With these risks and the difficult and heart-breaking circumstances of many children, the Furaha Community Foundation operate three safe-houses where the most vulnerable, at-risk young girls and boys go for protection and a safe place to live. In addition they get to attend the Furaha primary School.

Each safe house has a resident matron or patron.

Each safe-house looks after between 8-10 girls or boys. (Currently they have one boys safe-house and two girls safe-houses).

They provide a bed, daily meals, tutoring re their school work, daily devotions, medical and social care for the most vulnerable – either for a specific period or through their entire schooling years.

In this caring, safe environment the girls and boys find love, care and hope.

South Valley Community Church has been helping Furaha and the safe-houses for several years and with the growth of a third safe-house are applying to enable this third safe-house to help more young vulnerable girls find safety and protection.
