Due to this existing condition, the tapered crickets shown on the drawings in this location were no longer needed, thus providing a credit of \$1933.00. DDAP/SCG shared that during demolition, it was discovered that the exterior wall framing at the areas of the dropped boxed soffit did not extend to the roof deck and stopped only inches above the dropped ceiling. There was no support or barrier and the insulation was damaged, hanging loose and missing in some areas.
