## ABC Black Caucus 2019 Final Activity Report

#### Overview

The Caucus leadership team consists of Dr. Trinette V. McCray, President, Judge Albert Mathews, Secretary, Mrs. Clem Winbush, Treasurer.

#### Activity

The Caucus leadership continued to meet regularly using virtual platforms to structure our on-going work and communicate to our membership about our direction and aims. That communication was delivered via email and on the Black Caucus Facebook page.

Trinette McCray attended Inter-caucus meetings which were by conference calls. Clem Winbush attended the McKee Consultation held in Alaska in April. The Black Caucus sponsored a refreshment break during the conference.

The Black Caucus sessions during the 2019 Biennial/Mission Summit in Virginia Beach, VA, June 20<sup>th</sup>-23<sup>rd</sup> celebrated the 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the Caucus. The Caucus was formed in 1969 resulting from the demands for inclusion, representation and a more forceful Black voice in the ABC. The "Black Churchmen" as they called themselves, established an intentional set of demands which became their active agenda and mission. These events were extremely well attended. Our Thursday evening Opening worship preacher was Rev. Dr. Marsha Brown Woodard. The Friday morning Forum had over 125 participants. The annual banquet was at capacity with 225 attendees. The speaker was Rev. Dr. Leslie D. Callahan.

New materials were developed to communicate to the American Baptist constituency about the Black Caucus. These materials were printed in bulk by an outside company. They include: An historical brochure covering the beginnings of the Caucus, the early founders and leaders through the years; several placards that share the progress of Black leaders, staff and executives in the ABC over the 50 years of the Caucus, and a give-away of church fans displaying the photos of Black leaders in the ABC. These were distributed at the booth during the Mission Summit.

We are still focused on completing the writing of the history of Black American Baptists and partnering with Deborah Van Broekhoven, former Executive Director of the American Baptist Historical Society for its deposit in their archives and in publishing the material.

During the 2021 Mission Summit meeting of the Caucus, we will present for affirmation the revised By-Laws that will bring the outdated references and processes into alignment with the new ABC structure and processes.

Currently, we are engaging constituents with interest in re-establishing regional black caucuses.

We will attend and participate in any Inter-caucus meetings that may be planned for 2020 and any related AB gatherings.
