Role of the Office of the General Secretary

The role of the Office of the General Secretary is defined by our missional priorities and shaped by our values. Governance

The Office of the General Secretary carries the planning and leadership responsibility for the Biennial Mission Summit, the National Leadership Council, the National Executive Council, and the Mission Table. These events are planned for and by the entire ABC family.
