

Biennial Mission Summit | June 23-25, 2023 San Juan, Puerto Rico

Since I last shared an update with you in June, quite a few things have taken shape. The schedule of the Biennial Mission Summit, including additional sessions occuring at the event, is confirmed. We have received commitments from all workshop leaders as well as any organizations which will offer a meal event. A copy of the schedule follows this report.



Worship Services

I previously shared that we are excited to welcome Rev. Dr. Frederick Haynes, III, as our Friday night speaker, Rev. Miriam Méndez as the Saturday night speaker, and Rev. Joy Martinez-Marshall as the Sunday night speaker. Rev. Méndez has agreed to preach in Spanish on Saturday evening. The Sunday morning worship service will feature Rev. Laura I. Ayala-Álvarez who will also preach in Spanish.

Jeremy Fackenthal, Biennial Producer, has begun meeting with the Liturgical Team whose work will include determining the sub-themes for worship services and crafting the worship service program while highlighting the diversity of ABCUSA with intentional diversity and inclusion. The Liturgical Team will also work with the music coordinator to showcase a variety of music and worship styles throughout the weekend. It is our hope to extend the diversity of participants into the house band as well.

Workshops

Following the 2019 Biennial Mission Summit in Virginia Beach, workshop leaders expressed a concern that persons lingered in the meeting rooms well past the end of meal events and previous workshop sessions. To prevent this from happening again, we have extended the time between sessions to 30 minutes, which will also allow people a chance to spend time chatting with other attendees. Additionally, to encourage people to exit as promptly as possible I am hoping to find musicians and/or other performers who will play music and create a festive atmosphere in the hallways outside of these areas. If you have any suggestions for persons who we could contact for such a time as this, please let me know. It is our hope that they would already plan to attend the event so no additional expense is incurred.

Registration Fees

Registration will open on November 1, providing an opportunity for people to register in 2022 helping to spread the cost of attending the event over two years. A number of different registration options and discounted fee structure will be available. This includes:

Cvent Software

We will once again use Cvent software for our event website and corresponding registration process. Additionally, we have elected to use the Attendee Hub platform which will be included in every registration category except for Guest and PR One Day Participant. All sessions taking place on the main stage will be streamed live to the Attendee Hub and recordings of these sessions will be available to view online through September 23, 2022.

The use of the Attendee Hub provides us with the ability to utilize the polling feature to have Delegates vote online during the opening worship and business sessions. This system also includes an Event App which attendees will be encouraged to download prior to attending so they can check the schedule, access the Program Book, and more.

Another tool that we will use is the OnArrival platform which will allow attendees to use a kiosk upon arrival to self check-in and print their name badge. Volunteers from the Local Arrangements Committee will be present to distribute lanyards and welcome bags to attendees, and inform Delegate that the Delegate Packets can be found online. This tool will give us real time registration numbers needed to determine whether we have a quorum.

This year everyone's name badge will have a small unique QR code on the front. The code will contain information about all sessions the individual has selected and any meal events they have purchased. The OnArrival package includes 8 handheld scanners that will be used to scan badges to permit entrance into all of these sessions. A concern was raised by a few of the 2019 workshop leaders that more persons attended the workshop than expected which caused some people who had registered for the workshop to be left without a seat or standing in the hall. Persons who preregistered for a session will be admitted first, others will be able to enter as long as seats remain available.

Biennial Budget

A draft of the biennial budget was previously shared with the executive committee. I used conservative attendance numbers when estimating registration fee income as we are unable to estimate whether person will feel comfortable attending.

The Sponsor, Exhibitor and Advertiser Prospectus has been drafted. A copy will be posted for your review prior to the meeting. Please do not share this prospectus. There are a few organizations that we will approach prior to distributing this publically. We have taken a new approach to Sponsor opportunities this year. Rather than use the standard Gold, Silver, Bronze designations, we are offering opportunities for organizations to be a *Connecting* Sponsor, *Worship* Sponsors, *Registration* Sponsor, *Lanyard* Sponsor, or *Children and Youth Program* Sponsors.

Additionally, we will try a new approach with our partner organizations by offering them a Partnership Proposal that includes all of the items they would normally "purchase" for the biennial, such as exhibit booth spaces, advertisements, and a/v for the luncheons, as well as additional opportunities for promotion and recognition during the event. The amount we request from each partner will be based upon their past support of the 2017 and 2019 events.

Other Items

In an effort to exhibit our own concern for Creation Justice and the environment, we will not print program books for all attendees, but rather offer a printed commemorative program book which can be purchased for a nominal fee during the registration process. This will also reduce the cost associated with producing more than enough copies for distribution. The program book will be available online and in the Attendee Hub for all participants.

I invite you to prayerfully consider attending the event yourself following the BGM meetings. Since transportation to Puerto Rico is provided with your need to travel for the board meeting, and your registration as a BGM Delegate is covered by the Representative Process budget, the out of pocket cost to you is minimum. Your presence and assistance at the ABCUSA Pavilion in the exhibit hall would be greatly appreciated.

I am very excited about the program content and the new tools and features we will be using at the 2023 Biennial Mission Summit in San Juan. If you have any questions or feedback you would like to share, please let me know.


