WHAT DID YOU LIKE MOST ABOUT THE 2023 BIENNIAL MISSION SUMMIT EVENT?



Out of 219 responses to the question “What did you like most about the 2023 Biennial Mission Summit Event?”, the most common answer was **WORSHIP** with 71 responses mentioning the word.

WHAT STOOD OUT TO YOU THE MOST ABOUT THE 2023 BIENNIAL MISSION SUMMIT?

Out of 195 responses to the question “What stood out to you the most about the 2023 Biennial Mission Summit?”, the most common answer was **WORSHIP** with 47 responses mentioning the word.

Many Comments spoke about the level of Diversity within the Speakers/Preachers:

Women/Woman/Female (20)

Diversity (9)

AWAB (9)

Women in Ministry (6)

Two specific speakers were called out in the feedback:

Almost all the comments from what stood out **MOST** spoke of positives about the event; however, there were some that had concerns related to the content of the event as standing out the most:

- Pushing Women - “Woke” left -Political Agendas
- Narrow focus of Biblical text - Overall Attendance

DID YOU DISLIKE ABOUT THE 2023 BIENNIAL MISSION SUMMIT?

Out of 195 responses to the question “What did you dislike about the 2023 Biennial Mission Summit?”, the most common answer was **MUSIC** with 21 responses mentioning the word.

The major issue related to **MUSIC** stemmed from lack of options/similarity.

Most of the concerns related to the same type of issues:

“Woke”, AWAB, Diversity (too many women), Exclusion of Men, Pushing Liberal Agenda, Political Agendas, Pushing Anti-God/Anti-Bible Messaging (almost always about LGBTQ)

The remaining Issues related to:

Food/Pricing/Overall Expenses (27)

Time/Schedule of Events (20)

Volume (9)

Smoke Machines (4)

Almost all the comments from what stood out **DISLIKE** spoke of concerns about the event; however, there were some that had only positives related to the content of the event as standing out the most:

- Everything went well - I enjoyed everything - Nothing -Regular
