Report of the General Secretary - June 2024

On February 1, I began to serve as the General Secretary of American Baptist Churches USA. The ABCUSA staff greeted me warmly and planned a wonderful reception for my first day in the office. I have also received welcoming notes and flowers from regional, national and ecumenical partners. I am gaining a deeper understanding of the staff as I met with all staff members individually, enabling them to share the specifics of their day-to-day responsibilities, likes and dislikes, growth interest, their impact on ABCUSA's mission and purposefulness in their contributions, and lastly desired professional development. I completed these conversations in April. I continue to review the budget with Alan Musoke to gain insight into the budget process and the assumptions used to build the annual budget.

Biennial/Omaha Nebraska 2025:

- Modifying reporting lines to improve operational and administrative efficiencies.

This initiative supports our Mission Table Priority, *Empowering Young Adults and Youth* and strengthens and enhances our relationship with our National Executive Council (NEC) partners.
