# Regional Ministries Report to the BGM from Jeff Woods Activity Highlights from July 1 to November 15, 2024

Search Committees and Orientations for New Executive Ministers

- ABC of Vermont-New Hampshire completed its search process and is in the process of presenting their Executive Minister candidate to the board.
- ABC Mission Northwest is in the early stages of their search process following the retirement of Rev. Charles Revis.
- The Philadelphia Baptist Association is designing the Interim Executive Minister job description following the retirement announcement of Dr. James McJunkin.
- ABC of New York State has formed their search committee and is conducting listening sessions for their Executive Minister search following the retirement announcement of Dr. James Kelsey.
- I conducted exit interviews with Dr. James McJunkin and Dr. James Kelsey.
- I provided the charge to the region for the installation of Rev. Dr. TaNikka Sheppard.

# Regional Consultations and Events

- I led a region board retreat for the ABC of Greater Indianapolis.
- I preached and led workshops at the GRR Annual Meeting.
- I participated in the Cleveland Baptist Association Annual Meeting.

- Rev. Stacy Emerson stepped down as the Stewardship Consultant to ABCUSA in September, having been involved with The Generosity Project.

This will be achieved through intergenerational workshops, worship services, and shared meals.

In consultation with Rev. Dr. Gina Jacobs Strain, General Secretary, we submitted seven nominations for American Baptists to serve on the Trustee Committee, Members Committee, and Commissions of the **Baptist World Alliance**.

Bridget Lipin and Wendy Clemmer represented ABC's staff at the **World Relief Committee** meeting in October 2024. The Committee approved \$10,000 for the General Secretary's Pastoral Support Initiatives for fall 2024. Additionally, the Committee will vote in November for potential extra funds for 2025. American Baptist Churches requested a policy change to the World Relief Committee Manual, stipulating that all **One Great Hour of Sharing (OGHS) funds** be processed through American Baptist Churches, as OGHS is an ABCUSA fund. The current policy manual states:

## 11.0 FINANCIAL PROCEDURES

11.1 RECEIPT OF FUNDS. All undesignated One Great Hour of Sharing offerings should be sent through normal American Baptist Mission giving channels. Those funds are received by the Office of the General Secretary's Treasurer's Office and held in an account there. Exception: When there is a disaster of special concern to either IM or ABHMS, the relevant Board will be permitted to have funds designated for that specific disaster relief sent directly to them, as long as those funds are recorded as OGHS when received. When there is a disaster within a specific Region, the Region is permitted to receipt and retain funds designated for that specific disaster that come from churches/individuals within their Region. The funds must be recorded as OGSH when received.

The exception was established in 2013 to allow ABHMS and IM to process OGHS donations through their websites and by check for designated projects. ABHMS has been providing details on OGHS donors to American Baptist Churches as requested. However, International Ministries shares only some donor information and is unwilling to disclose all details, which is detrimental to ABCUSA. The committee agreed that they could not vote on a policy change without knowing the legal ownership of the donor information.

# **Transition Ministries ABCUSA**

The vision of Transition Ministries ABCUSA is to partner with regions in resourcing churches during times of transition in a way which enhances their ministry and empowers them to journey into the future as vibrant missional congregations.

Navigating through covid has presented many challenges, impacting the number of intentional interims available to serve in a variety of locations as well as the number of churches able to call full-time intentional interims. Nevertheless, we continue to live out our mission of recommending intentional interim ministers who are adept and experienced in leading churches through times of transition. These interim pastors guide the congregation on a journey that involves celebrating their history, clarifying their identity, articulating their mission, and moving into a fruitful future.

**Training** – Given the positive responses to an on-line training we conducted, we've been exploring further on-line as well as in-person trainings, as we continue to partner with regions in recommending intentional interim to congregations in need.

#### American Baptist Spiritual Direction and Formation

During Covid, we re-ignited an initiative that was begun about ten years ago as part of the Transformed by the Spirit movement. This initiative is a way for those who are involved in the ministry of spiritual direction to resource, connect and network with each other as well as to invite people into practices that ground us in God, strengthen our interconnectedness, undergird our life together and deepen our faith. The Spiritual Direction Team of Rev. Betty Wright-Riggins, Rev. Judy Fackenthal, Rev. Brad Berglund and I as staff liaison are all certified Spiritual Directors.

As part of this initiative, we are continuing to renew and refresh a website that will include resources for those seeking to deepen spiritual practices as well as for certified Spiritual Directors to connect: www.abspiritualformation.com.

- North American Baptist Fellowship (NABF) as part of the Executive Team, planned a leaders retreat to Dialogue, Discover, Dream, and Discern the future of NABF. During the business session I was elected one of the two Vice-Presidents.
