The ABCUSA Committee on Christian Unity and Interfaith Relations will be sponsoring a peace-building tour April 15-26 (to 30th with Jordan extension), 2015, in partnership with the Church of the Brethren and the Progressive National Baptist Convention. This visit will introduce you to the complex issues at play in this region that so desperately cry out for peace and to those who are actively working to build peace in the region.

We begin our tour by participating in a two day peace conference in Nazareth that is sponsored and hosted by the Association of Baptist Churches of Israel. We will engage in discussions of issues and challenges for Christian peacemaking in our time. This will give us a real feel for how Christians in Israel view the possibilities for peace.

Following the conference we will spend 7 1/2 days in a journey of understanding led by the Telos Organization. Following this part of the journey, there is also the option of continuing into Jordan to visit refugee settlements and view significant historical sites such as the site of Jesus' baptism and the Treasury at Petra.

The Telos Group (www.telosgroup.org) will be our guides for the land package. We have travelled with Telos before, and are impressed with their intentionality of exposing us to the persons and issues that tell the story of life today in what we call the Holy Land. They include visits to sacred sites (or ancient stones) but emphasize the "living stones," persons who embody the struggle for justice and peace today.
