The 2021 online Biennial Mission Summit will feature scheduled programming on each of the three event days, Thursday-Saturday, June 24–26, 2021. A sampling of event offerings include: eight workshops on unique topics, opportunities to join together with American Baptist Caucuses, hear ministry and mission stories from some of our national partners, a selection of Mission Summit Conversations, a comedy presentation, and three evening worship sessions designed to bring together one body of American Baptists as we Imagine Unity, Imagine Healing, Imagine Hope. *Learn more about all of these things inside this issue of* CONNECTIONS!

Plan now to come together with other American Baptists, where you will have access to numerous online resources and recorded workshops through our On-Demand Library. In addition, all registrants will have access to the Library for 90 days after the event. Each of the evening worship sessions, along with eight live workshop sessions on Friday and Saturday afternoons, will be recorded and available for viewing for 90 days.



How can we as Christians demonstrate our love to the world regardless of whether we live in a "blue" or "red" state and regardless of which political candidates we might have voted for?
